OUR MISSION: To provide abused and neglected children with quality advocacy in the court system and to secure a safe, permanent, and nurturing home for them by recuriting, training, and supporting a diverse network of Court Appointed Special Advocate volunteers.

For children who've been abused or neglected, CASA means having a home instead of feeling lost, and being a priority instead of feeling invisible.



An additional (7) advocates will be sworn on November 28th & will be assigned to children's cases during the month of December.

In 2017, (72) CASA children's cases closed with 97% of the children achieving safe & permanent homes.

102 court reports were drafted by CASA volunteers &

102 court reports were drafted by CASA volunteers & 86% of their recommendations became orders of the court.

SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE


Over 100 school bags and supplies were provided to every school age child in 2017!
